Remarks by Ambassador Aftab Ahmad Khokher, Group of 77 & China Handover Ceremony, 28 February 2024

Excellencies, Ladies and Gentlemen,

It was a great honour and a privilege to serve as Chair of the Group of 77 and China in Vienna.

Pakistan has always abided by its commitment to the G77 and the values, ideals and principles it espouses. In this regard, I am profoundly grateful for the support and trust in our work by all Member States of the Group to advance the common political and economic interests of developing countries. I am also grateful to the Member States of the Asia Pacific Group for endorsing Pakistan's candidature for Chair of the Group. I also thank UNIDO for its contribution to the Group in financially supporting the Office of the G77 Vienna Chapter since its establishment in 1998 and urge all Heads of all UN organisations present today to further support the Office of the G77 Vienna Chapter in its work.

When Pakistan assumed this immense responsibility, we were cognizant of the multiple and multidimensional challenges being faced by the international community, especially by developing countries. Moreover, the Group, for the first time, achieved a consensus statement delivered at the 5th Session of the Ad-Hoc Committee on Cybercrime held in April 2023 which highlighted important contributions to strengthen international cooperation, address challenges posed by ICTs for criminal purposes.

In the context of **UNIDO**, the Group continued to be a leading force in enhancing the work of the organization, and encouraged it to pursue its objective of fostering inclusive and sustainable industrial development in developing countries.

Moreover, the Group also worked towards promoting peaceful uses of nuclear technology and strengthening technical cooperation in the **IAEA**.

At the **CTBTO**, the Group made progress towards the formulation of a focused and comprehensive capacity-building framework.

In **COPUOS**, the Group defended and advanced its position on the need to promote the contribution of the peaceful uses of outer space to sustainable development and reiterated the need for **UNOOSA** to be sufficiently funded and staffed in view of its important mandate.

Finally, at **UNCITRAL**, the Group held several briefings in coordination with the Secretariat to help familiarize Member States with both new and ongoing discussions in the six Working Groups.
